

Activity sheet

KS 2 & 3 – Mini United Nations



- Divide into six groups: Nigeria; Pakistan; Bangladesh; Ethiopia; Rwanda; and Vietnam.
- Each person completes the 'Delegate form' using the 'Top trumps' country cards; and 'Education around the world' and 'Behind the scenes at the UN General Assembly' factsheets.
- Write your opening statement. This shares information about your country.
- Once you have written your opening statement, make a name badge.
- Each group selects someone to read their opening statement.
- Organise the classroom into a conference setting.
- Welcome to the mini- UN General Assembly!
- Share your opening statement, listen to everyone else's, and ask questions.
- Join together in pairs to decide on your negotiating positions: Nigeria and Pakistan; Bangladesh and Ethiopia; and Rwanda and Vietnam. Make a note of your negotiating position on the 'Delegate form'.
- Each pair selects someone to read their position to the Assembly.
- Present, listen, and ask questions in a full class discussion / mini UN General Assembly.
- The class treaty can be written up, signed by all, and shared far and wide.
