KS4 - Global Education Top Trumps



- Get yourselves into groups of four.
- Shuffle and deal all twelve cards face down. Each player holds their four cards so that they can see the top card only.
- The player to the dealer's left starts by reading out any category from the top card, e.g. 'Ratio of girls to boys in school'.
- The person with the best or highest value wins. That player collects all the cards from the round, including their own, and moves these cards to the bottom of their pile. It is then their turn to choose a category from the next card.
- If two or more cards share the top value or data is not available for that
 particular subject, then all the cards are placed in the middle and the same player
 chooses again from the next card. The winner of the hand takes the cards in the
 middle as well.
- The person with all the cards at the end is the winner!




