KS2/3 - Local to Global activity



Read our Local to Global factsheet. Cut out and muddle up the boxes below. Ask the children to read each statement and put them in order from local, to national, to international actions, to see how one person, like you, can affect how global policies are made.

People vote and elect a MP to represent their constituency

You write a letter/email to your MP about Send My Friend to School 2015

The MPs visit schools, hospitals and hold events to meet people, hear their ideas and find out what is important to them e.g. education for all

MPs meet in parliament to debate and discuss issues

MPs hold committees to develop new laws and initiatives

The UK government votes to decide how much money should be spent and what it should be spent on e.g. increase funding for international aid

The Minister for International Development decides how to spend the money internationally to support education in developing countries

World Leaders meet up and set new targets so that all children can go to school
