Ethiopia – Many children go to school in Ethiopia. For every one teacher there are 50 students.

India – The number of children missing school has dropped from 17 million to 1.4 million.

Spain – Spain stopped giving money to help children go to school.

Grade: C

Bangladesh – Lots of children go to school in Bangladesh. Many disabled children do not go

to school.

Colombia – The number of children missing out of school is going up quickly.

Grade: D

Pakistan – Over 5 million children do not go to school.

Grade: D

Nigeria – Over 10 million children do not go to school.
